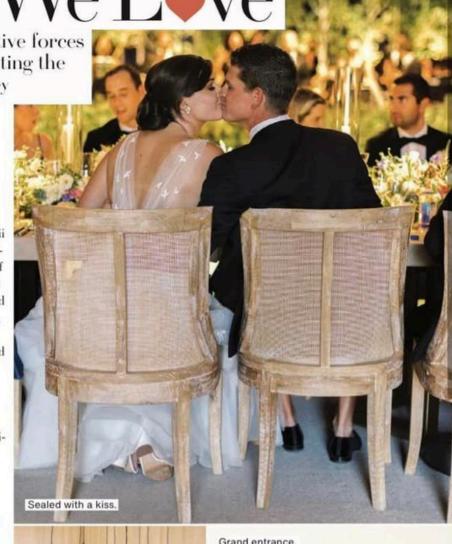

  going strong."
